What We Offer

- Regular GP-led ward rounds at your care home
- Prompt review of urgent clinical concerns
- Medication reviews and support with prescriptions
- Coordination with care home staff to ensure continuity of care
- Advance care planning discussions and documentation
- Support with managing long-term conditions and palliative care

How It Works

Our GP or nurse practitioner visits your care home routinely as part of planned ward rounds. These visits are coordinated with care home managers and staff to identify residents who need medical attention. We also remain available for advice and urgent issues between visits.

Communication and Support

We work closely with care home staff, families, and other health and social care providers. Our goal is to provide seamless care that reflects each resident's preferences and clinical needs.

Universal Care Plans (UCPs)

As part of our care for residents in care homes, we actively support the creation and maintenance of Universal Care Plans (UCPs). UCPs are digital care plans that ensure each resident's preferences, clinical needs, and personal goals are shared with all



relevant health and care professionals. They help us deliver coordinated and timely care, especially during emergencies or out-of-hours services.
